



Cargo Aircraft Operation

Cargo operations at the airport are conducted by FedEx, using a Boeing 757 to and from its primary sorting facility in Memphis, TN. There are an additional 6 Cessna Caravans operating on FedEx feeder routes from Casper to Cody, WY; Scottsbluff, NE; Hayden, CO; Sheridan, WY; Gillette, WY; and Rock Springs, WY. UPS also provides cargo operations at the Airport.


