

Renner to give home tour on 'House Hunter'

Kenn Renner moved to the Lake Travis area in May of 2007. A real estate broker, Renner applied to HGTV's "House Hunters" to see if he could have one of his clients' homes featured on the network.

"They told me they were actually looking to do a show on someone who was buying a \$1 million home," Renner said. "I told them that I was the only person I knew that was doing that."

The next thing he knew, HGTV camera crews were parked in his front lawn to film a segment. That segment will appear on Thursday, April 24 at 9 p.m.

"The house we purchased is Rob Hutton's former house after they moved to Steiner Ranch," he said. "It is right next to the lighthouse and has a pool, a sports court on three acres."

Renner gave camera crews a tour of three houses in the area.

"Each one of them had to be similar in size, square footage and price," Renner said. "It took a

long time to do the segments. Each house was about 5,000 square feet and each one took a full day to shoot. Sometimes they make you do the tour up to three times per home."

Renner said the other two homes will also be featured during the show when it airs.

"The first home we went to was on Trail of the Woods in the Hudson Bend area," he said. "Then we toured a house in the

Volente area on Beuregard Street."

"House Hunters" is the number one rated show on HGTV.
