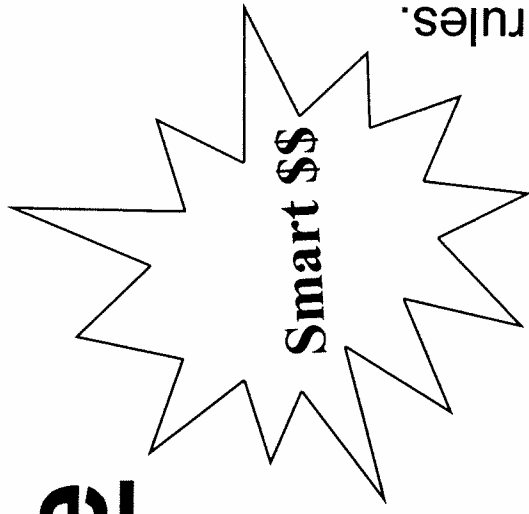
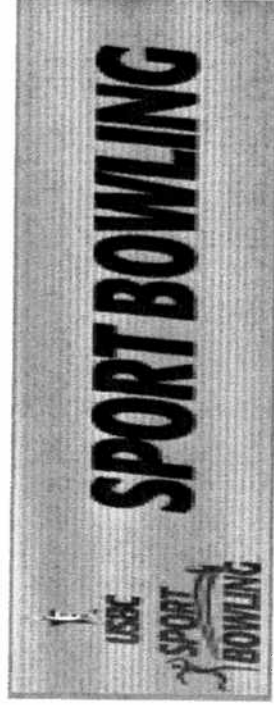

**Eligibility:** Open to all USBC-certified youth, twelve years old and up (based on August 1, 2008). Official Sign up is April 23, 2008 6:30-7:30 PM at Beaver Vu. You may pre-register by contacting Ty Davidson. **Registration fee \$15.00.**

**Schedule:** The league will bowl on Wednesdays at 7:00 pm (check-in time: 6:30 PM) for 13 weeks beginning May 7 and concluding on July 30, 2008. The entire house schedule is posted on front side of flyer..

**Sport Compliant:** The league will participate on PBA Sport conditions. Each pattern will be scheduled in advance will all athletes receiving a playbook at registration. This playbook will have all the patterns, graphs and “how to” section. The league will pay for the sport card **upgrade** for each participant.

**Dress Code:** A polo style shirt required for competition each week. Shorts and jeans are permitted for this league, hats/head covers are not permitted at anytime.

**Format/Scoring:** This is a singles tournament-format league. Each week, all bowlers will bowl a three (3) game qualifying round. The top eight (8) bowlers (to include top qualifying female), based on the 3-game series score rolled in the qualifying round, will advance to a bracketed, single elimination championship round.

**Bracket:** 8th place: the lowest losing score in the 1st Championship bracket. 7th place: the 2nd lowest losing score in the 1st Championship bracket. 6th place: the 3rd lowest losing score in the 1st Championship bracket. 5th place: the highest losing score in the 1st Championship bracket. 4th place: the lowest losing score in the 2nd Championship bracket. 3rd place: the highest losing score in the 2nd Championship bracket. 2nd place: the loser of the 3rd Championship bracket. 1st place: the winner of the 3rd Championship bracket. 9th place through the balance of the field: 3-game series score of the qualifying round.

**Cost:** The cost per bowler per week is \$13.00. Breakdown: \$9.00 lineage, \$3.00 for the awards and \$1.00 to Wright State Collegiate Bowling in lieu of secretary fees.

**Handicap:** Handicap will be based on 80% of 200. Maximum handicap per bowler per game: 40 pins (150 average). Handicap based on scores rolled in this league from the 1st week of league participation.

**Attendance:** There is no pre-bowling or post-bowling. Substitutes are allowed to bowl for a regular for only three weeks and must have a book average for the last year that is lower than the regular's book average. **A minimum of ten (10) weeks participation is required to be eligible to compete in the championship round.**

**Points:** Every bowler will earn points each of the twelve (12) weeks in which the bowler participates. Points will not be earned at the end-of-season Championship Tournament (week 13). Points will be earned each week based on the following formula:

Participation:	20 points	5th Place:	10 points
1st Place:	30 points	6th Place:	8 points
2nd Place:	25 points	7th Place:	6 points
3rd Place:	20 points	8th Place:	4 points
4th Place:	15 points		

Bowlers will earn 1 point for every bowler who finishes below the bowler in the Qualifying Round. *Points based on placement and performance are earned every week in which you bowl. The more weeks you bowl, the more points you earn. End of season 1, 2 & 3 place point leaders will receive awards.*

**Championship:** This league will conduct an end-of-season Championship Tournament July 30, 2008 in which all bowlers who bowled in this league no fewer than **ten (10) weeks** may participate. **Format:** The end-of-season Championship Tournament format will consist of a three (3) game qualifying round which will advance the top four (4) bowlers along with each week's champion for a field of 16. The championship round will consist of a bracketed, single game elimination format.

**Awards: Smart money scholarship based on number of players-see league awards\*\*\***

**Trophies:** **Each week-** Top qualifier and Weekly Champion.  
**End of season -** Point leader end of season—1st, 2nd & 3rd  
Championship & Runner-up  
High average, game & series (HDCP & Scratch) Boy & Girl

**Compliance:** In the event of a dispute not specifically covered by our league rules, bowlers agree, by their voluntary participation in this league, the authority of league management will adjudicate all disputes, (subject to USBC rules) and what is deemed to be in the best interest of this league.
