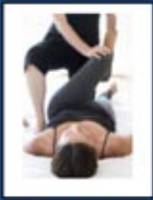

Now You're Cooking



Chicken and Sausage Cajun Chili

All you need:

2 tbsp (30 mL) olive oil

1 lb (500 g) ground chicken

½ lb (250 g) Italian sausage (casing removed)

1 cup (250 mL) each diced onion and green pepper

1 pouch (28 g) Club House Cajun Chicken Flavourful Recipe Mix

1 can (796 mL) no salt added diced tomatoes with juice

1 can (156 mL) tomato paste

2 cups (500 mL) water

1 can (540 mL) kidney beans, rinsed and drained

All you do:

Heat oil in large skillet over medium-high heat. Brown chicken and sausage meat 3 to 5 minutes. Stir in onion, pepper and seasoning. Cook until soft, about 3 minutes, stirring constantly.

Stir in tomatoes, tomato paste and water. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat, cover and simmer 25-30 minutes.

Stir in drained kidney beans in last 10 minutes of cooking.

Notes - recipe makes 8 cups (2 L) chili.

Lemon and Herb Shrimp

All you need:

2 tbsp (30 mL) olive oil

½ cup (125 mL) each sliced onion, celery and red pepper

3 slices bacon, chopped (raw)

1 lb (500 g) large shrimp

1 pouch (28 g) Club House Lemon Thyme Pork Flavourful Recipe Mix

1 cup (250 mL) low sodium vegetable broth

Juice from 1 lemon

1 tsp (5 mL) cornstarch

All you do:

Heat oil in a large skillet over medium-high heat.

Add onion, celery, red bell peppers and bacon, cook for 1 minute.

Add shrimp, seasoning and continue to cook for 1 minute.

Stir together vegetable stock, lemon juice and cornstarch and pour over shrimp mixture.

Cook 1 to 2 minutes or until sauce thickens and shrimp turn pink, stirring constantly.

Makes 4 servings.



Stained Glass Holiday Cookies

Ingredients:

1 box (128 g) coarsely crushed Allan Fruit Buddies, any flavour

1 cup (250 mL) granulated sugar

¾ cup (175 mL) butter, softened

1 egg

1 tsp (5 mL) vanilla extract

2 ½ cups (625 mL) all-purpose flour (approx.)

½ tsp (2 mL) baking powder

Pinch salt

Directions:

Beat sugar with butter, on medium speed, until light and fluffy. Beat in egg and vanilla until incorporated. Stir flour with baking powder and salt. Mix the flour mixture into the butter mixture, in two additions, just until combined. Knead dough lightly until smooth. Divide dough into two equal portions and form into disks. Wrap disks in plastic wrap; chill for 30 minutes.

Preheat oven to 375°F (190°C). Roll the dough out, on a lightly floured surface, ¼-inch (5 mm) thick. Use holiday cookie cutters to cut out cookies. Arrange cookies, at least 1-inch (2.5 cm) apart, on parchment-lined baking sheets. Use smaller cutters or a paring knife to cut out shapes from the centres of the cookies (leave at least ¼-inch (5 mm) borders around interior shapes).

Fill the cut-outs with candy cane pieces but don't overfill. Bake for 8 to 10 minutes or until golden around the edges and candy centres are evenly melted. Cool cookies completely on the baking sheet before lifting to allow centres to set. Cookies can be stored in an airtight container for up to 5 days. Makes about 3 dozen cookies (using 3-inch/8 cm cutters).

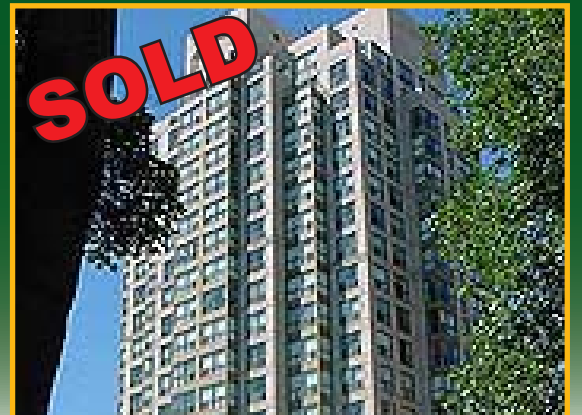

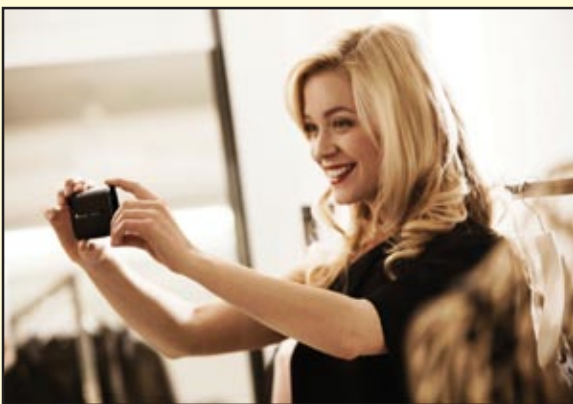

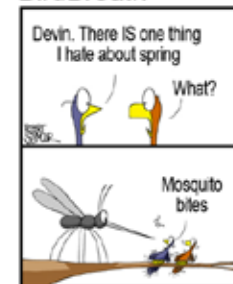
